TITLE: Public Hearing - Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program

Substantial Amendment

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the substantial amendment to the Annual Action Plans for 2016-17 and 2017-18 program years for \$500,000.

Background

The substantial change policy of the City's Housing and Urban Development (HUD) approved Consolidated Plan requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan if the addition or cancellation of a program or a change in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiary of an activity occurs. Such change requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan. The City of Fort Lauderdale's program amendment and substantial change policy requires Commission approval after proper notice has been published for a 30-day open comment period including neighbors' input at a public hearing (Exhibit 1).

These funds will be used to provide Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) pool ramps or lift stations for individuals with disabilities to gain access to the pool at the following City Parks:

- Carter Park
 1450 West Sunrise Blvd
 Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311
- Lauderdale Manors Park 1340 Chateau Park Drive Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311
- Bass Park
 2750 NW 19th Street
 Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311

The amendments are in accordance with HUD regulations and will allow the projects to proceed for completion.
