

CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE ANNUAL ACTION PLAN PROPOSED COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) AMENDMENT (30 Day Public Comment Period)

The City of Fort Lauderdale is considering amending grant years (FY) 2015, 2016, and 2017 Annual Action Plan for its CDBG program. In accordance with the Substantial Change Policy of the City's HUD approved Consolidated Plan, any changes in CDBG-assisted activity as a result of the addition or cancellation of a program or a change in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiary of an activity, funding allocation, requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan. The City of Fort Lauderdale's program amendment and substantial change policy requires Commission approval and public input at a public hearing after proper notice has been published for a 30-day public comment period.

The proposed amendments as requested by the Fort Lauderdale City Commission are as follows:

FY 2015 - \$393,812.54 **Uncommitted**

FY 2016 - \$ 7,146.91 **Uncommitted**

FY 2017 - \$ 99,040.55 **Uncommitted**

FY 2017 - \$500,000.00: Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) pool ramps; Cater Park, Lauderdale Manors Park & Bass Park - **Unencumbered**

The uncommitted and unencumbered funds will be for the creation of a Private Property Rehabilitation Program, and alternatively, the La Lee YMCA /Mizell Community Center project located at: 1409 Sistrunk Boulevard, Fort Lauderdale Florida 33311.

These amendments are in accordance with HUD regulations and will allow the projects to proceed to completion.

In accordance with federal regulations, the City is hereby establishing a 30-day public comment period to receive input on the proposed amendments. Comments on the proposed changes may be submitted to the City of Fort Lauderdale, Housing & Community Development Division, 914 Sistrunk Blvd. Suite #103, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33311. Public comments on these items will be accepted during the 30-day public comment period from March 29, 2019 to April 29, 2019. All comments must be received by April 29, 2019. The City will evaluate all comments received during the comment period, and the final amendment will be submitted to the Commission at a public hearing.
