Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations for the installation of a four-post boat lift located at 1180 N. Federal Highway #510, Slip #11.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow mooring structures to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 (C) of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the installation of a four-post boat lift extending a maximum distance of +/- 30 feet from the property line into the Middle River. At the March 7, 2019 Marine Advisory Board meeting (see **Exhibit 4**), the MAB reviewed a similar application from this applicant located at a different slip location (slip # 22), and tabled the item due to concerns specific to the slips ability to accommodate a vessel without impinging upon the submerged land lease. The applicant has since changed their slip assignment to current location.

The summary description specifies that the additional distance for the boat lift and associated finger pier are necessary to protect the resident's vessel as it is located adjacent to a water skiing area.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required.

The MAB recommended unanimous approval of the application 9 to 0 (see Exhibit 3).
