TITLE: Motion to Approve Consent to Assignment of Contracts for Professional

Services from CH2M Hill Engineers, Inc. to Jacobs Engineering Group Inc.

- (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve consent to assignment of contracts, in substantially the form attached, for professional services from CH2M Hill Engineers, Inc. ("CH2M Hill") to Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. ("Jacobs").

Background

On September 7, 2011, the City awarded Contract No. 606-10482-2 to CH2M Hill for General Wastewater Consultant Professional Architectural Engineering Services (CAR 11-1122).

On March 7, 2017, the City awarded Contract No. 466-11723-7 to CH2M Hill for Civil Engineering Consultant Services, Continuing Contract (CAM 17-0261).

On December 15, 2017, CH2M Hill merged with Basketball Merger Sub Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Jacobs, in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and Plan of Merger. This merger is consistent with the disclosure contained in the proxy statement/prospectus that forms a part of the Registration Statement on US SEC Form 8-K attached as Exhibit 3.

Resource Impact

There will be no fiscal impact to the City associated with this item.
