TITLE: Motion to Approve Donation to A Child is Missing from State Law
Enforcement Trust Fund - \$5,000 - **(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a donation to A Child is Missing in the amount of \$5,000 utilizing State Law Enforcement Trust Fund.

Background

A Child is Missing, a Fort Lauderdale-based, non-profit organization founded in 1997, is devoted to assisting law enforcement in the search and early safe recovery of children, elderly that are often diagnosed with Alzheimer's, disabled individuals and college students using their rapid-response, high-tech systems, which is similar to the reverse 911 system. Calls are placed to homes and businesses within areas designated by law enforcement. This service is provided to the Police Department at no cost and has a direct impact on the safe recovery of missing children and elderly neighbors. In addition, A Child is Missing provides Child Safety and Anti-Bullying Programs to 14 locations in our City. These programs are extended to at-risk kids that are on State supervision and reside in our City.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$5,000. This item is contingent upon the approval of Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM #19-0026.
