RESOLUTION NO. 19-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, DESIGNATING THE BUILDING, COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE "BUCCANEER MOTEL," LOCATED AT 3008 BAYSHORE DRIVE, FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AS A HISTORIC LANDMARK PURSUANT TO SECTION 47-24.11.B. OF THE CITY OF **FORT** LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS. **PROVIDING** FOR SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 47-24.11.B. of the Unified Land Development Regulations of the City of Fort Lauderdale ("ULDR") provides the procedures for designation of historic landmarks; and

WHEREAS, the applicant, Paula Yukna, submitted an application for the historic designation of the building located at 3008 Bayshore Drive in the City of Fort Lauderdale called the "Buccaneer Motel;" and

WHEREAS, at the public hearing held on May 6, 2019, the Historic Preservation Board reviewed the application, evaluated the testimony and other material presented and recommended the denial of the application for the designation of the building as a historic landmark based on criteria the provided in Section 47-24.11.B.6. subsections (a),(f),(g) and (h) of the ULDR; and

WHEREAS, notice of the public hearing to be held on Tuesday, May 21, 2019, at 6:00 o'clock p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the City Commission Chambers, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, was provided in accordance with Section 47-27.7, ULDR; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has reviewed the application and documentation supporting the application and finds that one or more of the criteria provided in Section 47-24.11.B.6. subsections (a),(f),(g) and (h) of the ULDR have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

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<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the above recitals are true and correct and incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby approves the designation of the building located at 3008 Bayshore Drive, Fort Lauderdale, as a historic landmark pursuant to Section 47-24.11.B.6. subsections (a), (f), (g) and (h) of the ULDR of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The building designated as a historic landmark is the "Buccaneer Motel" and legally described as follows:

LOT 7, BIRCH ESTATES, ACCORDING TO THE PLAT THEREOF, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 23, PAGE 24, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA

Location: 3008 Bayshore Drive, City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

As more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. That the designation shall take effect immediately.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. That the designated building is accorded all protection under applicable City ordinances now existing or subsequently enacted to preserve its exterior appearance, including protection from demolition.

<u>SECTION 5</u>. The City Clerk is hereby directed to provide a certified copy of this Resolution to the applicant and the property owner within thirty (30) days of the adoption of this Resolution, and to record a copy of this Resolution in the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. That if any clause, section or other part of this Resolution shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Resolution shall not be affected thereby, but shall remain in full force and effect.
