**TITLE:** Motion to Approve Contract for Purchase of Electrical Maintenance and  
Repair Services – Mills Electric Service, Inc. - \$199,834.60 -  
**(Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of electrical maintenance and repair services from Mills Electric Service, Inc., via Broward County Contract Y2113492B1\_1 - Electrical Maintenance and Repair, in the estimated expenditure of \$199,834.60.

**Background**

This project is needed to repair and rebuild the lowering devices associated with the high mast street lighting poles located on Oakland Park Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard. Each pole is required to have its fixtures lowered to ground level prior to hurricane winds approaching the area and is also needed to replace burnt out light fixtures. Currently, there are several inoperable lowering devices. As a part of this rebuild, the current high pressure sodium light fixtures are being upgraded to light emitting diode fixtures. The City is responsible for maintaining the high mast lights on Oakland Park Boulevard and Commercial Boulevard as a part of the State Highway Lighting, Maintenance, and Compensation Agreement dated May 19, 2003. As the maintaining agency, the City must perform all activities necessary to keep the lighting fixtures and poles fully operational.

Pursuant to Section 2-181(f)(5)(b), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, the City may piggyback a contract entered into by another governmental or public entity and a provider of supplies or services required by the City, if the Chief Procurement Officer determines that it is practicable and advantageous for the city to employ this method of procurement. The Chief Procurement Officer has determined that it would be practicable and advantageous for the city to use this method of procurement for this agreement. This purchase will be made in accordance with Broward County Contract No. Y2113492B1\_1 - Electrical Maintenance and Repair from Mills Electric Service, Inc. in the amount of \$199,834.60.
