A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE. FLORIDA; AMENDING RESOLUTION NO.19-86; DECLARING ITS NOTICE OF INTENT TO LEASE CERTAIN LANDS AND IMPROVEMENTS SITUATED THEREON, OWNED BY THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND LOCATED AT THE 5700-6000 BLOCK OF NW 31ST AVENUE, FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, PURSUANT TO SECTION 8.09 OF THE CITY CHARTER; DECLARING SUCH LANDS ARE NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC OR GOVERNMENTAL PURPOSES; AMENDING SECTIONS 4 AND 5 OF RESOLUTION NO. 19-86 TO PROVIDE NEW BID SUBMITTAL AND CITY COMMISSION EVALUATION DATES: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on May 7, 2109, pursuant to Resolution No.19-86 (incorporated herein by reference), the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale declared its intent to lease the lands and improvements located thereon as described in Resolution No.19-86 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Resolution No.19-86 established specific dates to receive and evaluate bids from persons interested in leasing the Property from the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida desires to amend Resolution No. 19-86 to modify the dates for receiving bids from interested persons to lease the Property and the evaluation thereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the Recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. Section 4 of Resolution No.19-86 is hereby amended by substituting June 10, 2019, with June 24, 2019.

<u>SECTION 3</u>. Section 5 of Resolution No.19-86 is hereby amended by substituting June 18, 2019, with July 9, 2019.

<u>SECTION 4</u>. <u>Ratification of Prior Resolution</u>. Except as specifically modified herein, all other provisions of Resolution No.19-86 shall remain unmodified and in full force and effect and are hereby confirmed by the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> <u>Severability</u>. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or word of this Resolution is for any reason held by the Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of Resolution No.19-86, as amended.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. The Effective Date of this Resolution is the date of adoption.
