TITLE: Motion to Approve Change Order No. 4 for A-13 Sewer Redirection – East

of Federal Highway Project – C & W Pipeline, Inc. – \$608,135.61 –

(Commission Districts 2 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve Change Order No. 4, in substantially the form attached, in the amount of \$608,135.61 for the A-13 Sewer Redirection Project, and add 233 calendar days to the contract with C & W Pipeline, Inc. ("C&W").

Background

On October 17, 2017, the City Commission awarded Contract No. 473-11979 for the A-13 Sewer Redirection (east of Federal Highway) Project to C&W in the amount of \$2,298,086 including allowances (CAM #17-1222).

Change Order No. 4 is for additional work associated with utility conflicts, weather delays, emergency repairs, and electrical changes. The Change Order also includes additional days to make up for delays in work, and costs for onsite equipment and labor associated with regulatory agency work stoppages and measures to reduce impacts to the traveling public.

Pursuant to Section 2-177, Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Change Order No. 4 requires Commission approval due to the cumulative value of the change orders exceeding 10% of the original contract amount.

Resource Impact

There is a fiscal impact on the City in the amount of \$608,135.61 for this change order. Funds for this change order in the amount of \$608,135.61 are available in the FY 2019 Community Investment Plan accounts listed below:
