A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE TO SIGN CERTIFICATES OF OWNERSHIP OF BURIAL RIGHTS (INTERMENT), ENTOMBMENT RIGHTS AND INURNMENT RIGHTS UPON COMPLETION OF PAYMENT OF THE WHOLE AMOUNT OF THE PURCHASE PRICE OF SUCH RIGHTS.

WHEREAS, Section 10-28 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida (hereafter "City"), entitled "Cemetery manager; qualifications, duties generally", specifically subsection (10) states:

"Selling lots, plots, crypts and niches. To sell such lots, plots, crypts and niches in the municipal cemetery system as are authorized by the cemetery system board of trustees under the restrictions imposed by such board and at the price set by the city commission, and to issue a certificate of ownership of burial rights, entombment rights or inurnment rights upon a payment of the whole amount, naming such special restrictions as are not set forth in this article, signed by the proper city officials and stamped with the seal of the city.";

and

WHEREAS, Section 4.01 of the City of Fort Lauderdale Charter provides that all contracts, agreements, leases or other instruments shall be executed in the name of the Mayor-Commissioner and the City Manager, and provide that the authority to execute such instrument may be delegated to another person by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission is desirous of delegating to the city manager, or his or her designee, the authority to sign certificates of ownership of burial rights (interment), entombment rights or inurnment rights upon completion of payment of the whole amount of the purchase price of such rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission hereby authorizes the city manager, or his or her designee, to sign certificates of ownership of burial rights (interment), entombment rights, or inurnment rights upon completion of payment of the whole amount of the purchase price of such rights.
