Parks and Recreation General Obligation Bond – **(Commission Districts
1,2 ,3 and 4)**

On March 12, 2019, Fort Lauderdale voters approved bond referendums to issue General Obligation (“GO”) Bonds to finance the acquisition, construction, renovation and improvement of various parks and recreational facilities throughout the City.

The purpose of this agenda item is to further discuss the Parks and Recreation General Obligation Bond with the Parks, Recreation and Beaches Board.
