A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT ADDITIONAL GRANT FUNDS AND EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO ACCEPT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE, STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGECY MANAGEMENT THROUGH THE CITY OF MIAMI FY 2017 URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$153,500.00.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) has provided financial assistance to the Miami urban area in the amount of \$4,921,000.00 through the Fiscal Year 2017 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the urban area is defined as the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) collectively, and

WHEREAS, the City has received additional funds from a sub-grant in the amount of \$153,500.00 with no required match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That City Manager is delegated the authority to accept a sub-grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management and execute any documents required to accept funds between the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale through the City of Miami FY2017 UASI in the amount of \$153,500.00.
