TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Cordova Road Seawall Replacement –
Custom Built Marine Construction, Inc. - \$5,759,237- **(Commission
District 4)**

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the Cordova Road Seawall Replacement Project with Custom Built Marine Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$5,759,237.

Background

The purpose of this project, as recommended in the Seawall Master Plan, is to replace approximately 2,166 linear feet of deteriorated coral rock seawall with new sheet-pile seawall along the east side of Cordova Road between SE 7 Street and SE 12 Street in the Rio Vista neighborhood. New stormwater infrastructure, pavement and landscaping restoration are required to drain the runoff from Cordova Road through the new seawall into the canal and are included in this project.

On April 4, 2019, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12256-493. The City received nine bids in response to the solicitation, which were opened on June 3, 2019. Three of the nine vendors that responded are either a Minority Owned Business Enterprise, Women Owned Business Enterprise, or Small Business Enterprise. All bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. The bid submitted by Custom Built Marine Construction, Inc. has met all of the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bid.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$5,759,237 for the contract award with the allowances included and \$287,962 for estimated in-house project management fees for a total of \$6,047,199. Funds for this purchase in the total amount of \$6,047,199 are available in the FY 2019 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below:
