

RESOLUTION NO. 19-133

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S 2045 METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLAN DRAFT COST FEASIBLE PLAN AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization approved the draft Cost Feasible Plan on May 9, 2019; and

WHEREAS, certain transportation projects have been identified and are currently ranked projects in the approved draft 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan Cost Feasible Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, a resolution from the City of Fort Lauderdale Commission stating support for the project is required for the project to be included in the final 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale will work with the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization, transportation partners, and the public, to prepare the projects for programming in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's Transportation Improvement Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida hereby supports the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's 2045 Metropolitan Plan.


SECTION 2. The office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.
