**TITLE:** Resolution Approving an Application for a Dock Permit for Usage of Public  
Property by Stephen and Kim Ann Shulman located at 116 SE 11 Avenue  
– **(Commission District 4)**

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution granting a Dock Permit for use by a private person of public property for Stephen and Kim Ann Shulman located at 116 SE 11 Avenue.

**Background**

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Dock Permit for use by a private person of public property in accordance with Section 8-144, Fort Lauderdale Code of Ordinances (Exhibit 2) for the use, maintenance and repair of an existing, approximately 20 feet long x 5 feet wide, fixed marginal dock adjacent to 116 SE 11 Avenue. The Marine Advisory Board unanimously recommended the approval of the application 14 to 0 (Exhibit 3).

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a permit for usage by a private person of public property, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required.

**Resource Impact**

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$300.00.
