- **TITLE:** Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute Documents Providing Consent to Wisdom Village Crossing, LP to Execute a Declaration of Restrictive Covenant with the County for the Wisdom Village Brownfield Site - (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute any and all documents necessary to provide consent to Wisdom Village Crossings, LP ("Owner") to execute a declaration of restrictive covenant with Broward County ("County") for the Wisdom Village Brownfield Site.

Background

The Wisdom Village Crossings development is a nine (9) story 105-unit multifamily project located at 615 North Andrews Avenue. The site is a brownfield site undergoing remediation and the Owner is required by Broward County Environmental Protection and Growth Management Department to execute a declaration of restrictive covenant. The City of Fort Lauderdale has a utility easement over the site and a revocable license agreement between the City, the County, and the Owner that encumber the property. In order to provide the declaration of restrictive covenant the Owner must receive consent from the City.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact.
