TITLE:	Motion Rejecting All Bids for the Fiveash Water Treatment Reliability Upgrades & Disinfection Systems Replacement Project - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission reject all bids for the Fiveash Water Treatment Reliability Upgrades & Disinfection Systems Replacement Project.

Background

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12235-293 for the Fiveash Water Treatment Reliability Upgrades & Disinfection Systems Replacement Project. The bid package for this project includes a wide variety of work such as constructing buildings to house new facilities, renovation of existing buildings and improving storm resistance, upgrading the plant's control system, replacing aged and obsolete equipment and reducing flooding.

On June 27, 2019, the City received two bids; both were significantly over budget. The lowest bid was \$47,291,000 while the projected construction budget for the project is \$32,000,000. Staff will review the bid package, reduce the scope where possible and rebid the project with line item pricing.

Resource Impact

There will be no fiscal impact to the City.
