Contained in the Procurement Ordinance for Procuring the Services of an
Architect in Connection with the Development of a Community Center at the
Site of the Former Lockhart and Fort Lauderdale Stadiums **(Commission
Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution waiving the competitive solicitation in the Procurement Ordinance for procuring the services architect in connection with the development of a Community Center at the site of the former Lockhart and Fort Lauderdale Stadiums and providing an effective date.

Background

On July 9, 2019, the City Commission entered into a Comprehensive Agreement with Miami Beckham United, LLC ("Inter Miami") and Approved the Qualified Project Pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 255.065, Related to City-owned Property Commonly Known as the Site of the Former Lockhart and Fort Lauderdale Stadiums (CAM 19-0706).

Pursuant to Section 4 of Ordinance No. C-19-11, which amended Subsection 2-176 (e), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, the competitive solicitation and solicitation processes do not apply to "purchases of goods or services for which the provisions of this article are waived by the city commission by resolution."

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City.
