with the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization for Downtown Fort Lauderdale Mobility Hub Project to Extend the Term of the Agreement for

One Year – (Commission District 2)

## **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the City Manager to execute a First Amendment to the Subrecipient Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization extending the grant term for an additional one (1) year.

### **Background**

The City of Fort Lauderdale is the subrecipient of a grant agreement with the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) via CAM 14-1357 (Exhibit 3) for the design and construction of streetscape improvements for the Downtown Fort Lauderdale Mobility Hub which expires December 31, 2019. (Exhibit 2) This grant is a pass-through from the Federal Transit Administration to the MPO. Due to unanticipated delays incurred while researching alternate scope options, additional time is required to complete the project. It is recommended that the City execute a First Amendment to grant agreement in order to extend the term for an additional one (1) year, thereby expiring on December 31, 2020 under the existing terms and conditions with the MPO.
