TITLE: Motion Approving Contract for the Modifications to Pump Station D-38

Project – Hinterland Group Inc. – \$662,960 – (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the Modifications to Pump Station D-38 project with Hinterland Group, Inc., in the amount of \$662,960.

Background

This Modifications to Pump Station D-38 project is part of the Consent Order between the City and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection and its purpose is to furnish all labor, materials, equipment, services, and incidentals for additions and modifications of the submersible Pump Station D-38. This project also includes coordination with Florida Power & Light for upgrades to the existing electrical service.

On July 17, 2019, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No.12305-493. Nine bids were received on August 19, 2019, and all bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. The bid submitted by Hinterland Group Inc., has met all of the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There is a current fiscal impact on the City in the amount of \$662,960 for construction and \$125,000 for estimated in-house project management fees for a total cost of \$787,960. Funds for this item in the amount of \$787,960 are available in the FY 2019 Community Investment Plan in the account listed below:
