NOTICE OF HEARING TO IMPOSE AND PROVIDE FOR COLLECTION OF FIRE SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS

Notice is hereby given that the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale will conduct a public hearing to consider imposing a fire special assessment fee for the provision of fire services within the Municipal Boundaries of the City of Fort Lauderdale for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2019.

The public hearing has been scheduled for 5:01 PM on September 12, 2019 in the Commission Chambers of City Hall, 100 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida for the purpose of receiving public comment on the proposed assessment. All affected property owners have a right to appear at the hearing and to file written objections with the City Commission within 20 days following August 23, 2019.

The assessment for each parcel of property will be based upon each parcel's classification and the total number of billing units attributed to that parcel. The following table reflects the proposed fire assessment schedule.

For the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2019, the Fire Assessed Cost to be assessed is estimated to be \$48,988,650 (net assessment after property exemptions are deducted). The Fire Assessments to be assessed and apportioned among benefited parcels pursuant to the Cost Apportionment and Parcel Apportionment to generate the estimated Fire Assessed Cost for the Fiscal Year commencing October 1, 2019, are as follows:

Copies of the Fire Assessment Ordinance (Ordinance No. C-99 49, as amended by Ordinance C-16-03), the Initial Assessment Resolution (Resolution No. 99-81), the Final Assessment Resolution (Resolution 99-100), the Preliminary Rate Resolution (Resolution 19-121) initiating the annual process of updating the Assessment Roll and imposing the Fire Assessments, and the preliminary Assessment Roll for the upcoming fiscal year are available for inspection at the City Clerk's office, City Hall, located at 100 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida. The assessments will be collected on the ad valorem tax bill to be mailed in November 2019, as authorized by section 197.3632, Florida Statues. Failure to pay the assessments will cause a tax certificate to be issued against the property, which may result in a loss of title.
