Unit 1608, slip #10, for the Installation of a Four-Post Boat Lift –

(Commission District 2)

#### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations for the installation of a four-post boat lift located at 1180 N Federal Highway at Unit 1608, slip #10.

### **Background**

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow mooring structures and mooring pilings to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 (C) and (D) of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the installation of a four-post boat lift extending a maximum distance of +/- 30 feet from the property line into Middle River.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required. The applicant's Summary Description specifies that the proposed boat lift is necessary to protect the berthed vessel as it is located adjacent to a water skiing area.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval of the application 10 to 0 (see Exhibit 3) at the August 1, 2019 meeting.

#### **Resource Impact**

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$300.
