TITLE: Resolution Granting a Waiver of Limitations at 2040 SE 17 Street for the

Installation of a Floating dock, Gangway, and Fixed Platform –

(Commission District 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations for the installation of a floating dock, gangway, and fixed platform located at 2040 SE 17 Street.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow mooring structures and mooring pilings to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 (C) and (D) of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the installation of a +/- 9,440 square foot floating dock, +/- 480 square foot aluminum gangway, and a +/- 70 square foot concrete fixed platform extending a maximum of +/- 69.3 feet from the property line into the Intracoastal Waterway.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required. The applicant's Summary Description specifies that the proposed floating dock and associated structures are necessary to safely moor vessels, especially during high wind and sever weather.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval of the application 9 to 0 (see Exhibit 3) at the August 1, 2019 meeting.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$300.
