

APPROACH TO SCOPE OF WORK

May 10, 2019

Upon award of the contract 40cean will begin servicing the City of Fort Lauderdale waterways in accordance with Section **3.4** regarding frequency and service areas. In addition, 40cean will respond to all special project calls by the next business day and in order of priority in accordance to Section **3.5**.

All 4Ocean Captains are USCG licensed, TWIC certified and uniformed along with crewmembers in standard 4Ocean shirts, hats and safety gear while operating 4Ocean branded boats and equipment in accordance with Sections **3.1** & **3.2**. Each boat is docked and deployed from a local marina. Today 4Ocean boats in South Florida waterways collect a daily average of 240 pounds of debris per boat. At the end of each service day, 4Ocean boat crews offload the collected debris where it is then sorted into recyclables and nonrecyclables. Recyclable plastics are processed and repurposed into 4Ocean products creating a sustainable circular economy around plastic and nonrecyclables will be disposed of at the city's designated disposal site in accordance with Section **3.3**. 4Ocean's mission to remove trash from the ocean and coastlines is supported by such pillars as optimizing technology. 4Ocean debris collection boats, equipment and machinery are pictured within this proposal.

4Ocean will utilize (1) Captain and crew member per Skiff and one Captain per Mobile Skimmer. Each 4Ocean vessel is equipped with ArgoTrak GPS and its tracking reports will be included within the weekly and monthly reporting to the city in accordance with Section **3.6**. In 2018 4Ocean boats averaged 240 pounds of debris collected daily while contractually servicing the waterways for the city of Boca Raton. This past April 4Ocean was awarded a renewal contract with the City of Boca Raton including (3) extension opportunities.

The City of Boca Raton and 4Ocean have developed a strong partnership over the past year in order to keep the city's waterways debris free which will continue into the foreseeable future. 4Ocean's mission to remove trash from the ocean and coastlines is a global movement and only able to grow through partnering with individuals, organizations and governments to work together for a cleaner ocean and waterways one pound at a time.

In 2018, 4Ocean pulled **124,000 pounds** of trash from Fort Lauderdale waterways on a <u>part-time</u> basis. Our goal is to partner with the City of Fort Lauderdale in order to provide the fulltime attention necessary for removing debris from its waterways now and into the foreseeable future.

METHODOLOGY

Work Schedule

Upon date of award, 4Ocean will begin servicing Fort Lauderdale waterways in 8hour shifts Monday, Wednesday and Friday. The 165 miles of waterways will be divided into North and South service routes. The complete 165 mile service route loop will be maintained and restarted every 4 weeks. When nonscheduled work is requested regarding debris collections, 4Ocean will send boat crew(s) to collect the debris in the requested area by the next business day should the request fall outside normal service days/hours.

Operation Plan

4Ocean utilizes (2) 24' Mobile Skimmers and (5) 25' Carolina Skiffs to navigate and clean the intracoastal waterways of South Florida. Each vessel has one USCG licensed Captain and one Cleanup Crew Member onboard. The Captain navigates the Skiff as the Cleanup Crew uses telescoping poles with nets to physically remove debris from waterways. The Mobile Skimmer uses articulating bow arms to collect debris which then is picked up via a conveyor system and deposited into the onboard debris bin. Debris is collected in 55gal bins or supersacks on the deck of the vessels. Once full, the vessel transports the bins to its respective marina where it is picked up by the 4Ocean Collection Crew. The Collection Crew consists of two full-time employees who transport the collected debris to 4Ocean Fleet Headquarters in Boca Raton. Recyclable materials are rinsed, weighed and sorted in 4Ocean facility. Organic and nonrecyclable materials and debris is taken to the city's designated disposal site for proper waste and recycling disposal. Disposal receipts will be retained and incorporated into regular reports.

Tracking & Reporting

4Ocean utilizes the ArgoTrak, a GPS service and software platform that allows live tracking of assets. ArgoTrak allows user to track live, history of routes traveled and different variables such as engine hours and miles traveled. Weekly reporting will include total weight collected, identified high impact areas and ArgoTrak coverage. Monthly reporting will include before and after photos of weekly collections in addition to aggregated weekly data and disposal receipts.




