Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the settlement of this employee theft claim with Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America by accepting the amount of \$101,937.69, and authorize the City Manager to execute on behalf of the City a Release and Assignment and an Authorization for Redirection of Restitution in the forms attached.

Background

The City purchased employee theft coverage through Travelers Casualty and Surety Company of America with effective dates of March 1, 2017, to March 1, 2018, which provided a limit of \$1,000,000 for employee theft losses subject to a \$25,000 retention (deductible).

The City submitted a claim in the amount of \$129,937.69 in connection with a former Parks and Recreation Department employee's unauthorized use of a City purchasing card. Travelers Casualty and Surety Company has agreed to pay the City \$101,937.69, which is the amount of the claim less the \$25,000 policy retention and less \$3,000 in restitution previously recovered by the City, subject to approval by the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There will be a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$101,937.69.
