

RESOLUTION NO. 19-169

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE PROPOSED MILLAGE RATE OF 1.00 MILL TO BE LEVIED BY THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR THE SUNRISE KEY NEIGHBORHOOD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020.

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable provisions of law, the City Commission has computed a proposed millage rate and prepared a tentative budget for the Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, a "Notice of Proposed Millage Rate and Tentative Budget Hearings" advising the public that a public hearing on the proposed millage rate and tentative budget would be held on September 3, 2019 at 5:01 P.M. in the City Commission Room at City Hall, 100 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida has been published as required in Florida Statute 200.065; and

WHEREAS, the National Hurricane Center forecasted a potential landfall of Hurricane Dorian on Florida's peninsula for Sunday, September 1, 2019 and Monday, September 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on August 28, 2019, Governor Ron Desantis, by virtue of the authority vested in him by Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Florida Constitution and by the Florida Emergency Management Act, as amended, and all other applicable laws, promulgated Executive Order Number 19-189; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority provided in Executive Order Number 19-189, the Executive Director of the Florida Department of Revenue promulgated Emergency Order Number 19-001 and authorized local governments to reschedule and advertise scheduled hearings cancelled after the issuance of the emergency order; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale advised the public that a rescheduled public hearing on the proposed millage rate and tentative budget would be held on September 12, 2019, at 5:01 p.m., in the City Commission Room at City Hall, 100 North Andrews Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida; and

WHEREAS, said public hearing has been held as stated above and comments from the public concerning said proposed millage rate and tentative budget have been heard and considered; and

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Broward County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the City of Fort Lauderdale as \$132,620,160; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale to adopt a proposed millage rate for the Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby adopted a proposed millage rate to be levied on all property, both real and personal, in the Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District, subject to ad valorem taxation for operating purposes, a tax of 1.0000 mill on the dollar of taxable assessed valuation of \$132,620,160 for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2019 and ending September 30, 2020 for the benefit of the Sunrise Key Neighborhood Improvement District, and for the payment of the appropriations set forth in the operating budget, which levy is designed to produce a total estimated tax collection of \$127,315 and which millage rate results in an 4.37 percent increase over the rolled back rate of 0.9581.

SECTION 2. That a public hearing to adopt a final millage rate and budget shall be held in accordance with Section 200.065, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 3. That this resolution will take effect immediately upon its adoption.
