

RESOLUTION NO. 19-177

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION AND SELECTION PROCESSES CONTAINED IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE PROCUREMENT ORDINANCE FOR PROCURING THE SERVICES OF AN ARCHITECT IN CONNECTION WITH THE DEVELOPMENT OF A COMMUNITY CENTER AT THE SITE OF THE FORMER LOCKHART AND FORT LAUDERDALE STADIUMS, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on July 9, 2019, the City Commission approved a Comprehensive Agreement with Miami Beckham United, LLC, for improvement of City-owned property commonly known as the site of the former Lockhart and Fort Lauderdale Stadiums ("Lockhart"); and

WHEREAS, included in the overall plan for the 64-acre property at Lockhart is a community center; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 4 of Ordinance No. C-19-11, which amended Subsection 2-176(e), Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, the competitive solicitation and solicitation processes do not apply to "[p]urchases of goods or services for which the provisions of this article are waived by the city commission by resolution.";

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the competitive solicitation and selection processes contained in the City of Fort Lauderdale Procurement Ordinance are waived for procuring the services of an architect in connection with the development of a community center at Lockhart.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
