TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute License Agreements

for Parking at City-Owned Property - (Commission District 1, 2, 3, 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute license agreements for parking at City-owned property.

Background

Subsection 4.01(b) of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, provides:

All contracts, agreements, leases or other instruments to which the city is a party and under which the city assumes any liability, shall be executed in the name of the city by the mayor and city manager, attested by the city clerk, and the form of any such instrument shall be previously approved by the city attorney or assistant city attorney, provided, however, that where by ordinance or resolution, the execution of short-term leases or other instruments is delegated to another person, such instrument may be executed in the manner provided by such ordinance or resolution.

The City negotiates with individuals, businesses and civic or charitable organizations to utilize city-owned property for parking. The delegated authority will allow the City Manager to execute license agreements that will not exceed two years, for parking at city-owned properties, subject to the approval of the City Attorney's Office.

Resource Impact
