PROPOSED COMMUNITY
DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
GRANT (CDBG) AMENDMENT
(30 Day Public Comment Period)**

The City of Fort Lauderdale is considering amending grant years (FY) 2014, 2015, 2017, and 2018 Annual Action Plan for its CDBG program. In accordance with the Substantial Change Policy of the City's HUD approved Consolidated Plan, any changes in CDBG-assisted activity as a result of the addition or cancellation of a program or a change in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiary of an activity, funding allocation, requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan. The City of Fort Lauderdale's program amendment and substantial change policy requires Commission approval and public input at a public hearing after proper notice has been published for a 30-day public comment period.

The proposed amendments as requested by the Fort Lauderdale City Commission are as follows:

FY 2014, 2015, 2017 and 2018 -Uncommitted HUD funds

The uncommitted funds in an amount up to \$300,000 will be for the creation of a Teen Center project at the Boys and Girls Club located at: 877 61st St, Fort Lauderdale Florida 33309.

The uncommitted funds in an amount up to \$150,000 will be for Fire Alerting Systems f located at FS2 and FS46 in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

In accordance with federal regulations, the City is hereby establishing a 30-day public comment period to receive input on the proposed amendments. Comments on the proposed changes may be submitted to the City of Fort Lauderdale, Housing & Community Development Division, 914 Sistrunk Blvd. Suite #103, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33311. Public comments on these items will be accepted during the 30-day public comment period from September 3, 2019 to October 3, 2019. All comments must be received by October 3, 2019. The City will evaluate all comments received during the comment period, and the final amendment will be submitted to the Commission at a public hearing.
