Block Grant Program - (Commission Districts 2 and 3)

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the substantial amendment for the allocation of up to \$450,000 of uncommitted Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds (2014-2015, 2015-2016, 2017-2018, and 2018-2019).

## **Background**

The substantial change policy of the City's Housing and Urban Development (HUD) approved Consolidated Plan requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plans of the Consolidated Plan, if there is a change in the purpose, scope, location, or beneficiary of an activity. The City's program amendment and substantial change policy requires Commission approval after proper notice has been published for a thirty-day open comment period.

This amendment is being undertaken to provide the City with the opportunity to strengthen our local community by providing funding for two significant projects.

- 1. The addition of a teen center at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Broward County, whose offices are located at 877 NW 61st Street, Fort Lauderdale for up to \$300,000.00
- 2. The installation of new Fire Station Alerting Systems for FS2 and FS46 up to \$150,000.00

The proposed projects were advertised for a thirty-day comment period as required by Federal Regulations. No public comments were received.

#### **Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact to the General Fund. The federal CDBG grant will reimburse the City for the funds expended on eligible activities.
