TITLE: Resolution Appointing Representatives to the Working Group and

Technical Group Relating to the Memorandum of Understanding with Broward County Regarding Collaborative Study and Development of an Integrated Solid Waste and Recycling System (Commission Districts 1,

2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission appoint a primary and alternate representative to participate in the Working Group, as well as a representative to participate in the Technical Group as outlined in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Broward County regarding a collaborative study and development of an integrated regional solid waste and recycling system.

Background

On September 12, 2019, City Commission approved the MOU with Broward County (CAM 19-0670). The MOU confirmed the City's desire to participate in the establishment and implementation of a regional solid waste management system, secured representation under any governing body established to govern any integrated solid waste and recycling system resulting from the MOU and provided the opportunity to request representation on both the Working Group and Technical Group providing recommendations.

The attached resolution establishes the City's appointments to the Working Group and Technical Group. The Working Group members (a primary and alternate) must be elected officials. The meeting frequency and time commitment to participate will be determined by the Working Group once formed. The Commission will need to discuss and decide who among them will fulfil these roles.

As City Manager, I am recommending Melissa Doyle, the Solid Waste and Recycling Program Manager, be appointed to represent the City on the Technical Group.

Resource Impact
