WHAT IS LAUDERTRAIL?

The LauderTrail initiative was created by the Fort Lauderdale City Commission in 2018 to develop an urban shared-use trail connecting various local and regional destinations. To help guide this initiative, the Commission assembled a Working Group tasked with identifying preferred paths, destinations, amenities, and potential sources of funding for designing and constructing the LauderTrail.

When completed, the LauderTrail will provide a comfortable and safe connection for people walking and biking throughout the City. LauderTrail will knit together neighborhoods and serve as the **SPINE** for the City's planned **ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION NETWORK**.

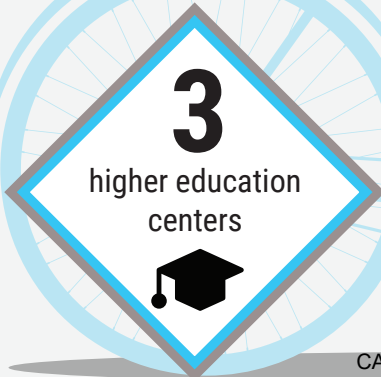
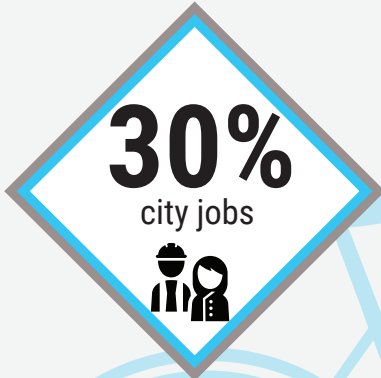
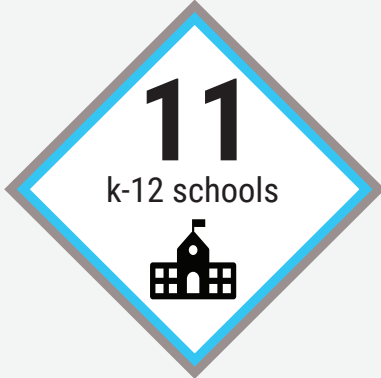
MISSION

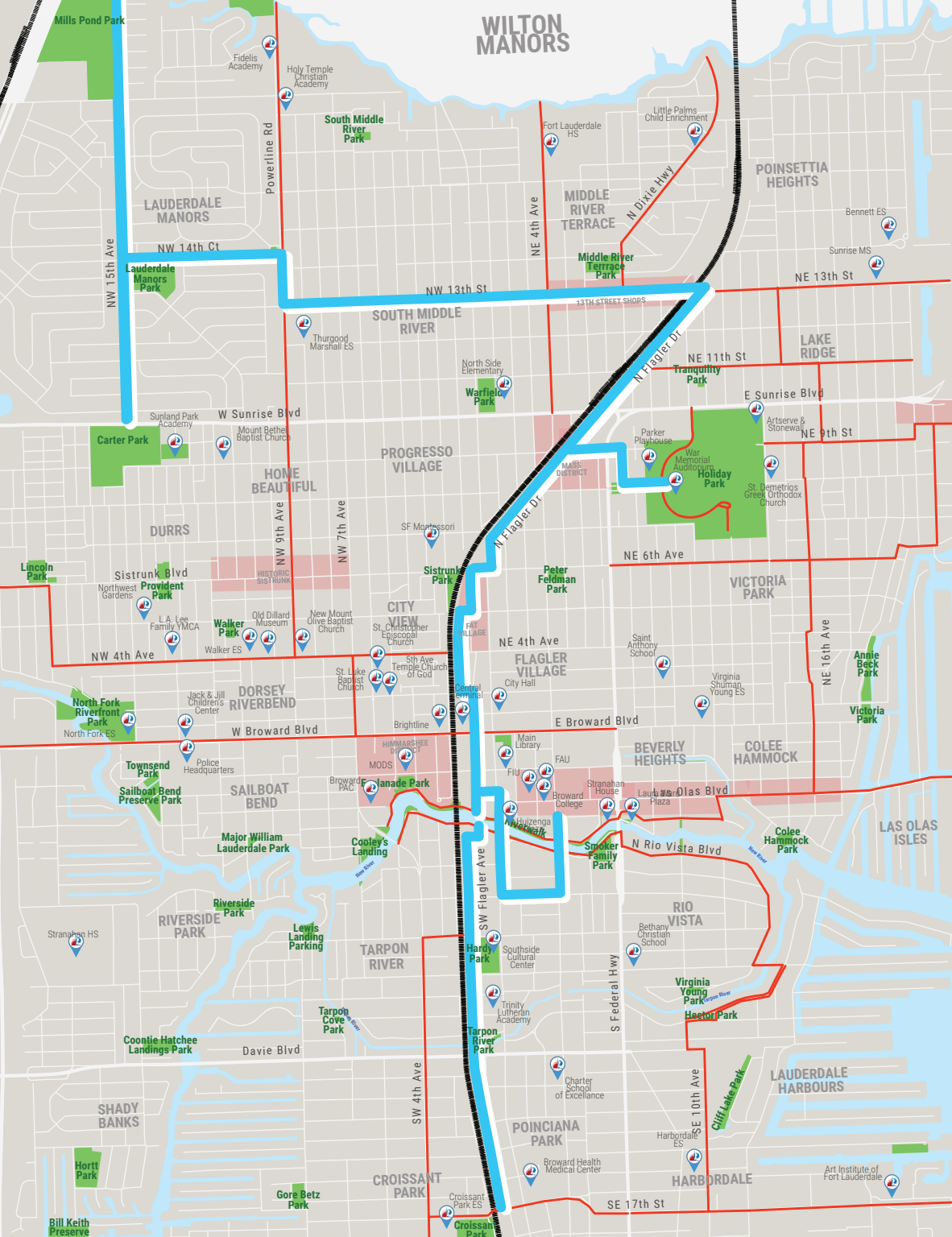

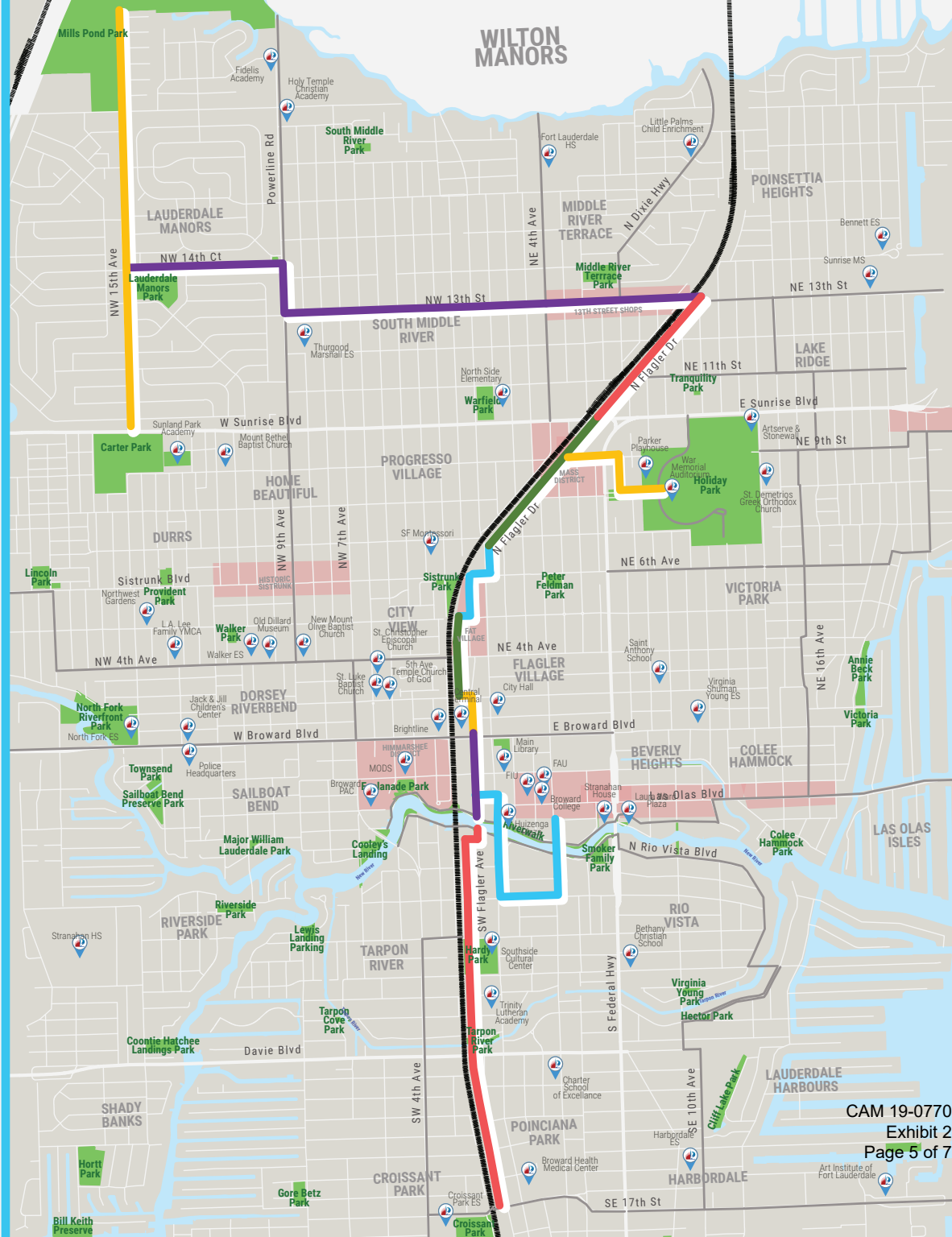
