- TITLE: Motion to Appropriate Unspent Remaining Central Beach and Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Estimated Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Year-End Operating and Incentive Fund Balances - (Commission Districts 2 and 3)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the CRA Board of Commissioners approve the transfer of the Central Beach and Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights (NPF) year-end estimated operating and incentive budget balances to the existing Community Investment Plan (CIP) Projects and Debt Service.

Background

Florida Statutes, Section 163.387 (7) requires that on the last day of the fiscal year of the community redevelopment agency, pursuant to an approved community redevelopment plan, any money which remains in the trust fund after the payment of expenses shall be:

- (a) Returned to each taxing authority which paid the increment in the proportion that the amount of the payment of such taxing authority bears to the total amount paid into the trust fund by all taxing authorities for that year;
- (b) Used to reduce the amount of any indebtedness to which increment revenues are pledged;
- (c) Deposited into an escrow account for later reducing any indebtedness to which increment revenues are pledged; or
- (d) Appropriated to a specific redevelopment project pursuant to an approved community redevelopment plan which project will be completed within 3 years from the date of such appropriation.

To comply with the above statute, staff recommends the following budget transfers to CIP Projects and Debt Service as follows:

• The Central Beach CRA FY 2019 year-end estimated operating budget balance of \$1,075,268 to the Las Olas Boulevard Corridor Improvements Project (P11900)

and \$100,000 to the Sidewalk and Paver replacement Program to replace deteriorating sidewalks and drainage in the Almond Avenue area.

 The Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights CRA FY 2019 year-end estimated operating budget balance of \$693,826 and Incentive balances of \$423,829; \$106,000 to the Sweeting Dock Replacement Project (P12278), and \$1,011,655 deposited in an escrow account to reduce indebtedness to which increment revenues are pledged.

Consistency with the Community Redevelopment Plan

The Sweeting Dock Replacement Project is consistent with the Northwest Progresso Flagler Heights (NPF) CRA Community Redevelopment Plan which provides for the enhancement of public parks, open space and infrastructure. The dock replacement shortage of \$106,000 will replace two previously demolished docks that were in poor condition and a hazard to residents.

The Las Olas Boulevard Corridor Project is listed as one of the four major public improvement projects in the Beach Community Redevelopment Plan's Concept and incorporates many of the planned public improvements that the CRA considers important to the successful redevelopment of the Fort Lauderdale's Central Beach Area.

The replacement of deteriorating sidewalks and drainage in the Almond Avenue area complies with the Beach Community Redevelopment Plan's goal of eliminating the conditions of blight, and with the Plan's policy under Other Public Improvement Projects of improving pedestrian/bicycle safety and replacing aging and antiquated infrastructure.
