TITLE:	Resolution Granting a Waiver of Limitations at 515 Idlewyld Drive, for the Installation of a New Concrete Dock and Elevator Style Boat Lift – (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a Resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations for the installation of a new concrete dock and elevator style boat lift located at 515 Idlewyld Drive.

Background

The applicant is seeking a resolution granting a Waiver of Limitations (a waiver to allow mooring structures and mooring pilings to extend beyond the maximum distance as defined by City Code) of Section 47-19.3 (C) of the Unified Land Development Regulations (ULDR) for the installation of a new concrete dock and elevator style boat lift extending a maximum of +/- 89.3' from the property line (+/- 33.2' from the wet face of the seawall) into the Intracoastal Waterway.

Although there is not a fee associated with obtaining a Waiver of Limitations, an application fee in the amount of \$300.00 is required. The applicant's Narrative Summation specifies that the proposed structures are necessary to protect the vessel from damage due to wave action resulting from navigational traffic.

The Marine Advisory Board recommended unanimous approval of the application 8 to 0 (see Exhibit 3) at the October 3, 2019 meeting.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$300.
