#### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission authorize the Mayor and City Manager to execute a one-year agreement with the School Board of Broward County (SBBC), Florida for the School Resource Officer Program commencing August 14, 2019 and concluding on June 3, 2020.

## **Background**

The City of Fort Lauderdale Police Department's School Resource Officer (SRO) Program assigns 10 law enforcement officers to serve as School Resource Officers at nine secondary schools operated by the SBBC. Fort Lauderdale Police Department officers are assigned full-time on the campuses of New River Middle, Sunrise Middle, William Dandy Middle, Fort Lauderdale High, Stranahan High, Whiddon Rogers, Sheridan Technical, Seagull Alternative and 2 officers at Dillard Middle/High. The SBBC will contribute \$54,600 per officer for a total amount of \$546,000 per school year. The SBBC reimburses the same amount per officer to all participating Broward County law enforcement agencies.

### **Resource Impact**

The Revenues related to this new agreement in the amount of \$546,000 will have a net positive fiscal impact of \$175,984 in the FY 2020 Operating Budget in the accounts listed below:
