TITLE:	Motion Accepting FY2019 Florida Department of Transportation Grant – \$45,360 - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the acceptance of a grant in the amount of \$45,360 from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT).

## **Background**

In July 2019, the City submitted an application to FDOT in response to a solicitation for proposals from law enforcement agencies to deliver public awareness and enforcement campaigns related to pedestrian and bicyclist safety, which is a component of Florida's Bicycle/Pedestrian Focused Initiative Communication & High Visibility Enforcement Implementation Project under the direction of FDOT and the Institute of Police Technology and Management. The grant's enforcement activities are being implemented to remind and educate pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorists of safe behaviors. The delivery of services must begin within 30 days of contract execution and must end on or before May 17, 2020.

## Resource Impact

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$45,360. The grant does not require matching funds. This item is contingent upon the approval of the Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM 19-1095.
