RESOLUTION NO. 19-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA DENYING A PLAT ENTITLED "NEW RIVER SOUND" AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the applicant, Summit Hospitality 134, LLC, submitted an application for approval of a plat entitled "New River Sound"; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission considered the application and the record and recommendations forwarded by the Development Review Committee, the Department of Sustainable Development, and the Planning and Zoning Board; and

WHEREAS, at its public meeting on December 17, 2019, the City Commission heard public comment on the application and determined that the proposed plat fails to satisfy provisions of Section 47-24.5. of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida Unified Land Development Regulations ("ULDR") and other applicable land development regulations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the plat entitled "New River Sound", as recommended for approval by the Planning and Zoning Board of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida on October 16, 2019, is hereby denied by the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida as presented for failing to satisfy the provisions of Section 47-24.5 of the ULDR.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The City Commission finds that the "New River Sound" plat fails to satisfy the provisions of Section 47-24.5 of the ULDR and other applicable land development regulations as enunciated and memorialized in the minutes of its meeting of December 17, 2019, a portion of those findings expressly listed as follows:
