The SAB received a presentation on October 28, 2019, from Todd Hiteshew, Environmental Compliance Manager in the Public Works Department, on the City's proposed enhancements to Section 28-4 of the City of Fort Lauderdale Code of Ordinances – Standards for Florida Friendly Fertilizer Use on Urban Landscapes. This will reduce algae growth and improve water and habitat quality.
