RESOLUTION NO. 20-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A LOCALLY FUNDED AGREEMENT AND AN ESCROW AGREEMENT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR POWDER COATED STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL MAST ARM ASSEMBLIES AT THE INTERSECTION OF SR A1A AND TERRAMAR STREET AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, FDOT plans to install and powder coat the trombone mast arms at the intersection of SR A1A and Terramar Street to match the existing black powder coated structures along SR A1A in Fort Lauderdale between Harbor Beach Parkway and NE 9th Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale ("CITY") will be required to maintain the aesthetic improvement in connection with FDOT'S project to install the mast arms; and

WHEREAS, the CITY is providing financial assistance to FDOT for the application of the black powder coating of the two trombone mast arms; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and FDOT wish to execute a Locally Funded Agreement in the amount of \$25,000.00 and execute an Escrow Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Locally Funded Agreement in the amount of \$25,000.00 and an Escrow Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for the application of the black powder coating of the street traffic signal trombone mast arm assemblies at SR A1A and Terramar Street.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. The office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.
