Automotive, Inc. - (Commission District 2)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Sixth Amendment to the Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement inclusive Agreement for State Road 838 (Sunrise Boulevard) with the Florida Department of Transportation for landscape improvements within the right of way of State Road 838 (Sunrise Boulevard) between Mile Post 1.033 to Mile Post 1.211 and an Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement, in substantially the form attached, with Holman Automotive, Inc.

Background

In December 2007, the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) entered into a Landscape Inclusive Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) (Exhibit 2) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the purpose of the City maintaining the landscape improvements on various roads including State Road 838 (Sunrise Boulevard). The Sixth Amendment includes provisions allowing the property owner, Holman Automotive, Inc, to construct additional landscape improvements or to modify an improvement on State Road 838 (Sunrise Boulevard) from Mile Post 1.033 to Mile Post 1.211, and in accordance with the plans attached as Exhibits "A" and "B" to the agreement. The Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement (Agreement) (Exhibit 3) between the City and Holman Automotive, Inc, passes the costs associated with the MMOA to Holman Automotive, Inc. Holman Automotive, Inc. agrees to assume the City's obligation to maintain the improvements installed by them, in the right of way in accordance with the agreement.
