

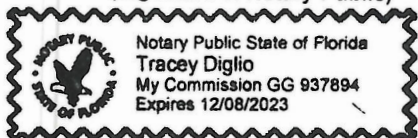

CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE ANNUAL ACTION PLAN PROPOSED AMENDMENT (30 Day Public Comment Period)

The City of Fort Lauderdale is considering amending grant years (FY) 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 Annual Action Plans for its Housing Opportunities for Persons with Aids (HOPWA) program. In accordance with the Substantial Change Policy of the City's HUD approved Consolidated Plan, any changes in activity as a result of the addition or cancellation of a program or a change in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiary of an activity, funding allocation, requires a program amendment to the Annual Action Plan of the Consolidated Plan. The City of Fort Lauderdale's program amendment and substantial change policy requires Commission approval and public input at a public hearing after proper notice has been published for a 30-day public comment period.

Funding Source: U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
Purpose: To provide continued HOPWA services including case management

The proposed amendments as requested by the Fort Lauderdale City Commission are as follows:

Public comments on these items will be accepted during the 30-day public comment period from January 8, 2020 to February 10, 2020. All comments must be received by February 10, 2020. The City will evaluate all comments received during the comment period, and the final amendment will be submitted to the Commission at a public hearing.
