TITLE: Motion Approving Contract for the Twin Lakes North Annexation
Improvements Project – FG Construction, LLC - \$176,527.89
(Commission District 1)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the Twin Lakes North Annexation Improvements Project with FG Construction LLC, in the amount of \$176,527.89.

Background

The subject project consists of safety improvements for the Twin Lakes North Neighborhood. The scope includes clearing and grubbing, installation of monument signs and round-about with concrete foundation, colored stamped concrete, asphalt paving, pavement striping, landscaping.

On December 21, 2018, the Procurement Division advertised Invitation to Bid ("ITB") No.12232-693 for the Twin Lakes North Annexation Improvements Project. One of the two vendors that responded has indicated its status as a Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise, or Small Business Enterprise. The Engineer's Estimate was \$185,000. On January 31, 2019, bids for Twin Lakes North Annexation Improvements were received as follows:

- Stanford Construction - \$398,882
- Sagaris Corporation - \$481,629

Since the lowest bidder exceeded the Engineer's Estimate by \$213,882, staff recommended the rejection of all bids and to re-bid the project. The City Commission subsequently rejected all bids on April 2, 2019, per staff's recommendation.

On August 20, 2019, the Procurement Services Division issued ITB No.12319-693 re-advertising the Twin Lakes North Annexation Improvements Project. Six bids were received on September 26, 2019, and the bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. Five of the six vendors that responded have indicated they are neither a Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise, nor Small Business Enterprise. The bid submitted by FG Construction, LLC is the lowest cost,

responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$176,527.89 for this contract award with allowances and \$14,125 for estimated project management fees. The estimated project total is \$190,652.89. Funds for this contract in the total amount of \$119,463 are available in the FY2020 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below with \$73,148 contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the consolidated budget amendment CAM #20-0088 on March 3, 2020.
