- TITLE: Motion Approving Increase in Funds to Contracts for Turf Grass Maintenance, SE, SW, NE, NW Quadrants and Fire Stations – C&M Landscaping, Inc. and VisualScape, Inc. - \$101,562 - (Commission Districts 1, 2, 3 and 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in funds to the contracts for turf grass maintenance services for the SE, SW, NE, NW quadrants and the City's fire stations with C&M Landscaping, Inc. ("C&M") and VisualScape, Inc. in the aggregate amount of \$101,562.

Background

The City currently has five contracts and two vendors for turf grass maintenance as detailed on Exhibit 1.

Per the City Commission Action Plan, turf grass maintenance services were increased citywide as well as at the City's fire stations. Mowing services were increased from 21 to 26 services and hedge trimmings from 9 to 12 services. Additional funds are needed to cover the cost of the increase in services. The Parks and Recreation Department is seeking City Commission approval to increase funds for all five contracts in the aggregate total of \$101,562.
