TITLE: Motion Approving Contract for Annual Asphalt, Sidewalk and Americans with Disabilities Improvements – General Asphalt Co., Inc. - \$1,000,000 (two-year total) - **(Commission Districts 2, 3 and 4)**

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, with General Asphalt Co., Inc., for the Annual Asphalt, Sidewalk and Americans with Disability Act (“ADA”) Improvements projects in the amount of \$1,000,000 and authorize the City Manager to approve two, one-year renewal options, contingent upon the appropriation of funds.

Background

This two-year contract is for the City’s Annual Asphalt, Sidewalk and ADA access ramps located in Community Development Block Grant qualifying neighborhoods. Work will include, but is not limited to, installation of Type S-3 asphalt, Florida Department of Transportation Superpave 9.5 asphalt, thermoplastic pavement marking, milling and leveling of existing asphalt pavement, sidewalk repairs, installation of ADA access ramps and other items quantified in the contract.

This contract also included milling and resurfacing of roadways in the qualifying neighborhoods with Pavement Condition Index (PCI) below 55, as identified in the City’s 2019 inspection by Tetra Tech, Inc., which are: Middle River Terrace, South Middle River, Progresso Village, Home Beautiful Park, Flagler Village, City View Town Homes, Downtown Fort Lauderdale, Dorsey Riverbend, River Garden Sweeting Estate and Durrs.

On January 29, 2020, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No.12363-603. The City received seven bids in response to the solicitation, which were opened on March 3, 2020. One of the seven vendors that responded indicated they are either a Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise, or Small Business Enterprise. All bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. The bid submitted by General Asphalt Co. Inc., has met all the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal year impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$500,000 for construction and \$54,000 for estimated in-house project management fees for a total cost of \$554,000. Funds for this contract in the amount of \$500,000 are available in the Community Development Block Grant and \$54,000 are available in the FY2020 Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below. Future expenditures are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the annual budgets.
