

RESOLUTION NO. 20-65

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$400,000.00) TO THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT FOR GEORGE ENGLISH PARK BOAT RAMP RENOVATIONS PHASE II CONSTRUCTION; DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT APPLICATION AND ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY OR INCIDENTAL THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida ("the City") is interested in completing the following described Project for the enjoyment of the residents and visitors of Fort Lauderdale, Broward County and the State of Florida:

Project: George English Park Boat Ramp

Brief Description of Project: Renovate the George English Park Boat Ramp to allow access for use by larger Boats and Trailers needed to meet the upgrade in area boater needs due to the replacement of the Sunrise Boulevard Bridge by the Florida Department of Transportation.

WHEREAS, Florida Inland Navigation District ("FIND") financial assistance is required for the Project referenced above; and

WHEREAS, staff is seeking additional grant funding in the amount of \$400,000.00 for eligible projects under the FIND Waterways Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.01(b) of the City Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale requires that Mayor, City Manager, City Attorney and City Clerk execute all contracts, agreements or other instruments to which the City is a party under which the City assumes any liability; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter further provides that the City Commission has the authority to delegate by resolution to another person the authority to execute these instruments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission hereby approves the Grant Application to the FIND Waterways Assistance Program in the amount of \$400,000.00 relating to the above referenced Project.

SECTION 2. That the City Manager of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida is hereby delegated the authority to execute the Grant Application and any and all necessary documents incidental thereto.


SECTION 3. The City Commission certifies its commitment of the Grant's matching funds.
