Brief Project Summary: A 40' Sailboat was abandon and sank in the IntraCoastal Waterway in January 2010. Palm Beach Police Marine Unit deemed the vessel derelict and is now eligible to qualify for grant funding to float and dispose of the vessel. It is a navigational hazard to area boaters who use the local waterways.
