Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve the settlement of the workers' compensation claim in the matter of Kelvin O'Neill v. City of Fort Lauderdale, Case No. 15-027143DAL in the amount of \$450,000.

Background

Kelvin O'Neill, a former Fort Lauderdale Fire-Rescue Department employee, filed workers' compensation claims for injuries that occurred on July 2, 2012 and September 21, 2015, while in the course and scope of employment with the City.

Through negotiations, a settlement was reached in the amount of \$450,000 subject to the approval of the City Commission.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$450,000.
