A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN COUNTY AND CITY OF **FORT** BROWARD THE FLORIDA, FOR REIMBURSEMENT LAUDERDALE. **ADMINISTRATIVE** ACTUAL NECESSARY AND COLLECTION COSTS INCURRED BY THE BROWARD COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR ASSOCIATED WITH THE FORT LAUDERDALE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT WITHIN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2019, the City Commission adopted a resolution of intent to use the uniform method of collecting a non-ad valorem assessment for costs associated with stormwater management; and

WHEREAS, Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, requires the taxing authority levying a non-ad valorem assessment to enter into a written agreement with Broward County for reimbursement of necessary administrative costs and actual collection costs incurred by the Broward County Tax Collector in performing its ministerial duties; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to execute an agreement with Broward County for reimbursement of necessary administrative costs and actual collection costs incurred by the Broward County Tax Collector in performing its ministerial duties associated with the Fort Lauderdale Stormwater Management non-ad valorem assessment commencing with the 2020 assessment roll;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement between Broward County and the City of Fort Lauderdale, in substantially the form attached as "Exhibit 1" to Commission Agenda Memo No. 20-0074, for reimbursement of necessary administrative costs and actual collection costs incurred by the Broward County Tax Collector in performing its ministerial duties associated with the Fort Lauderdale Stormwater Management non-ad valorem assessment commencing with the 2020 assessment roll.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
