TITLE: Motion Accepting a Grant of up to \$64,700.25 from the State Florida

Department of Environmental Protection / Clean Vessel Act Program for the Repair/Renovation of the New River Docking Facility Vessel Sewage Pump out System (Agreement number MV379) – (Commission District 4)

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a motion accepting a Grant award from the State of Florida Environmental Protection / Clean Vessel Act Program (FDEP) to fund up to 75 percent of the project cost for the renovation of the New River Downtown Docks Marshall Point vessel sewage Pump-Out System. This Grant requires a City match of \$21,566.75.

Background

The Clean Vessel Act Grant Program is a program of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). Since 1994, DEP has provided grants to marinas across the state to install pump-out facilities and to purchase pump-out vessels to further improve water quality in Florida's waterways.

At the City's New River Docking Facility there are two vessel sewage pump out stations which provide free pump out service to dock customers and area commercial and recreation vessels. One of the systems needs renovation and repair. The City received bids for the work and the total project costs are \$86,267 for system repairs. This Grant will fund up to 75 percent of these costs and the City is required to cover the remainder.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$64,700.25. The funding is contingent upon the approval of the consolidated budget amendment #20-0091.

Required funding match, in the amount of \$21,566.75, is already in place within the Parks and Recreation Marine Facilities FY 2020 operating budget.
