TITLE: Motion Approving Contract for the North Galt Shops Improvements Project
– Sagaris Corp. - \$958,792 - **(Commission District 1)**

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the North Galt Shops Improvements Project with Sagaris Corp., in the amount of \$958,792.

Background

This Project is located at North East 32nd Street and North East 33rd Avenue and North Ocean Boulevard, in the City of Fort Lauderdale.

During the June 5, 2018 Commission Meeting, the City Commission approved a budget amendment, (CAM 18-0224), to transfer funds, (\$577,432), to the project.

The work to be accomplished under this contract includes, but is not limited to: mill and resurface, replace curb and gutter, install new pavement markings and signages, install new irrigation system, modify sidewalk to compliance to current ADA code, install new decorative pedestrian lights, replace existing light fixture with LED light fixture, underground electrical work and conduit trenching, install root barrier and Silva Cell landscape system, remove and plant new trees, install new concrete wheel stops and relocate portions of the potable water and stormwater system away from the median. This project includes procurement, removal, disposal, construction, testing, and placing into service the equipment and materials shown on the Drawings and Specifications.

On March 27, 2020, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12395-903. The City received two bids in response to the solicitation, which were opened on May 6, 2020. One of the two vendors that responded indicated they are either a Minority Business Enterprise, Women Business Enterprise, or Small Business Enterprise. All bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. The bid submitted by Sagaris Corp. has met all the specifications of the solicitation and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bid.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$958,792 for the contract award which includes \$70,000 for the following allowances; landscape, irrigation, tree removal

and mitigation permit fees, underground infrastructure and roadway work allowance for a total of \$958,792. Funds for this purchase in the total amount of \$958,792 are contingent upon the approval and appropriation of the consolidated budget amendment CAM #20-0091 on June 2, 2020. If approved, the funds would be available in the FY2020 Community Investment Plan project identified as P12378.461.
